2. Check your file size (Maximum 25 M)
3. Tag new chapter titles as "Heading 1"

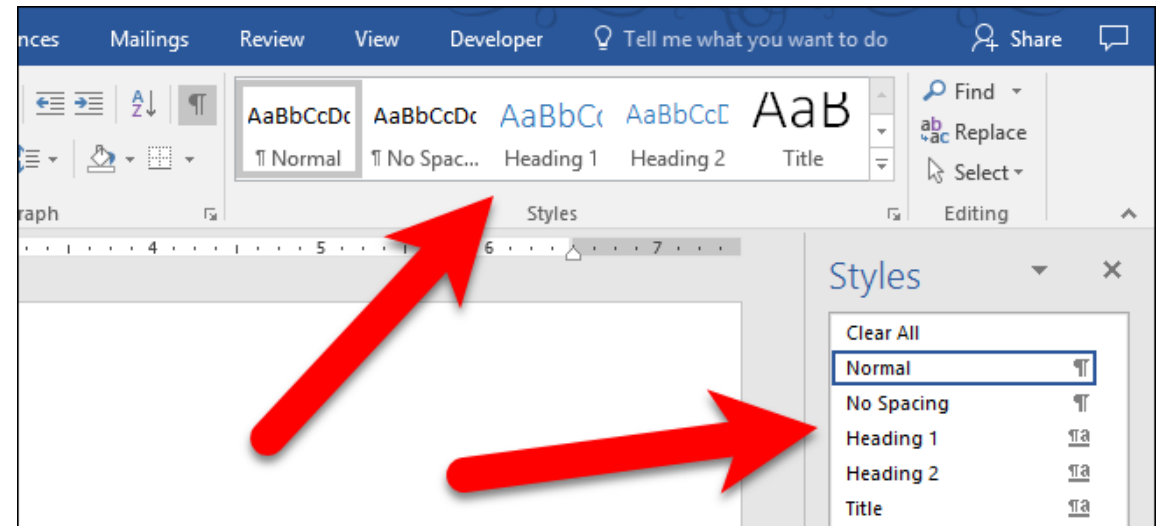
Pressbooks will recognize each "H1" as the title of a new chapter.

4. Use the styling pane.

Basic tags will translate (i.e. bold, Italics, etc.)

but special fonts & colours will not.

5. Make sure images have Alt-Text



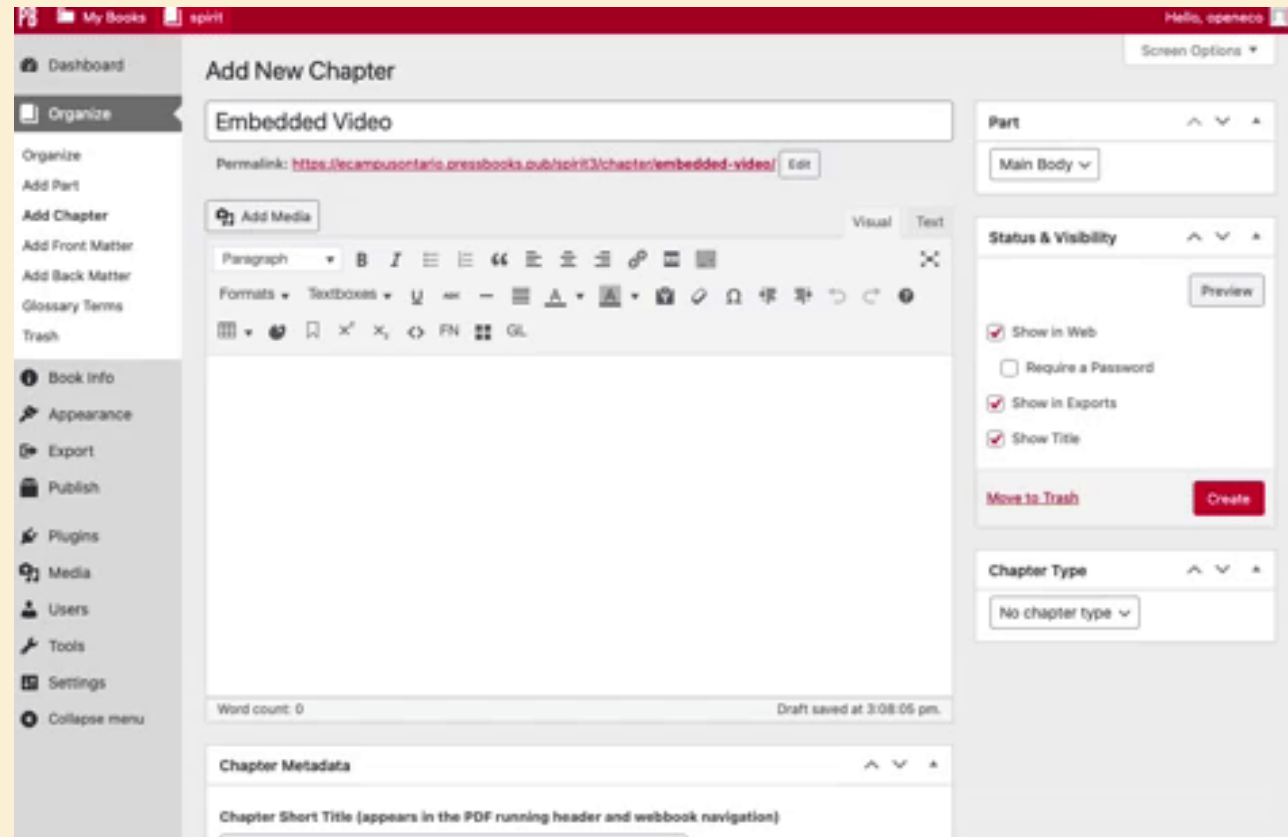

Example 7.1 J: Relationships as Functions

Express the relationship $2n + 6p = 12$ as a function $p = f(n)$ if possible.

To express the relationship in this form, we need to be able to write the relationship where p is a function of n , which means writing it as $p = [\text{something involving } n]$.

$$2n + 6p = 12$$

subtract $2n$ from both sides

$$6p = 12 - 2n$$

divide both sides by 6 and simplify

$$p = \frac{12-2n}{6} = \frac{12}{6} - \frac{2n}{6} = 2 - \frac{1}{3}n$$

Having rewritten the formula as $p =$, we can now express p as a function:

$$p = f(n) = 2 - \frac{1}{3}n$$

$$\text{[asciimath] sum_{(i=1)}^n i^3=((n(n+1))/2)^2[/asciimath]}$$



$$\sum_{i=1}^n i^3 = \left(\frac{n(n+1)}{2} \right)^2$$
